### Membership Category Information

**Active** – Actively employed veterinarian with full membership benefits (non-Colorado residents do not have the right to vote or hold office). Active member category now includes former categories of Public Sector and Non-Colorado Resident.

**Affiliate** – Non-veterinarian (e.g. practice manager, technician, commercial supplier) member with full membership benefits except the right to vote or hold office.

**Educational Institution** – Full membership benefits for each veterinarian authorized by the employing education institution. Payment for all veterinarians must be submitted at one time.

**Recent Graduate** – 50% discount on dues for the two calendar years following graduation with full membership benefits.

**Retired** – Full membership benefits for a veterinarian who has retired from the active practice of veterinary medicine.

**New Graduate** – Complimentary membership with full benefits to new graduates for the calendar year in which the individual graduates.

**Life Member** – Full membership benefits for a veterinarian who has been a member in good standing of CVMA for at least 40 consecutive years, or is 70 years of age or older and has been a CVMA member in good standing for the preceding 10 years.

**Practice Package** – With this new membership option, every veterinarian working 20 or more hours weekly in the practice becomes a CVMA member, and special benefits are delivered to the practice – including a complimentary Practice Diagnostic Report, a complimentary Personalized Fee Guide, and special member rates on Client Satisfaction Surveys and CVMA Performance Resources. **How it works:** The first member from a practice pays \$525 and each additional member pays the discounted dues rate of \$293 and also receives full membership benefits. This is CVMA's best value for the practice!

### Health Insurance

Health insurance coverage offered through the association is made available to all members regardless of any health status-related factor relating to an individual (or individuals eligible for coverage through a member employer). Health insurance coverage offered through the association is available only to members.

### Tax Information

CVMA dues payments are not deductible as charitable contributions for federal income tax purposes. However, they may be deductible as business expenses, except that portion attributable to CVMA lobbying activities, which is estimated to be 4%.
